## Terms and conditions for press accreditation NorthSide 2023

If you wish to cover NorthSide for a media, you have to apply for a press accreditation.

An accreditation gives journalists and photographers access to the festival and to the enclosed press zone with workstations available.

All medias are welcome to apply, <u>but we cannot guarantee an accreditation to everyone.</u>

There are several things you can do to improve your chances of being accredited.

## You can:

- Give a serious description of why you want an accreditation for NorthSide and what your editorial goal with the accreditation is: How do you plan to cover the festival? Which audience do you communicate to? What will be your focus area(s)? Approximately how many articles/reviews/pictures/posts/videos/radio broadcasts etc. do you imagine producing?
- Apply in good time if you have plans of larger productions during the festival (e.g., if you plan to record video and/or sound).
- Apply within the deadline.

## Terms and conditions for press accreditations for NorthSide:

- The press accreditation is personal and can under no circumstances be passed on to others. If you have been prevented from participating after you have received a press accreditation, please write to presse@downthedrain.dk as soon as possible.
- You must show respect to the other journalists and photographers in the press zone and to the festival's employees, volunteers and of course guests.
- You must ensure that you comply with GDPR rules (e.g., in relation to photography on the site)
- You must submit the products that have come out of your coverage of the festival (articles, reviews, videos, podcast episodes, etc.) by September 30, 2023. Please send these to <a href="mailto:presse@downthedrain.dk">presse@downthedrain.dk</a>.

- If these rules are not complied with, we reserve the right to cancel your accreditation with immediate effect.
