

Work safety at the festival

To maintain a focus on occupational health and safety, we must all act with care and use our common sense to avoid occupational injuries and expose ourselves - or others - for danger. Therefore, it all starts with YOU and all other employees at the festival.

Use your common sense on behalf of yourself and others - keep an eye on what is going on around you so you look after yourself...and help others to be aware of risks.

Therefore remember:

- Safety shoes**, when you are involved in building, moving heavy things ect. Or you are in an area where construction is taking place.
- Helmet**, when you are in an area where there is construction going on around you and especially above you.
- Gloves**, when building, lifting, moving things that can wear down or damage your hands.
- Safety vest**, when traveling in an area where trucks, lorries or similar are driven. Be especially aware of this if you work after dark.
- Eye and ear protection**, when sawing wood, cutting objects and other things that make noise and emit flying particles.

If you are missing some of the above-mentioned protective equipment, you can have them delivered at 'Warehouse' on the square.

General: Do not throw yourself into a task for which you are not trained or feel uneasy - truck driving, climbing, electrical work, handling dangerous tools etc. Also, take care of yourself even when you lift.

If an accident occurs, do the following:

In the event of dangerous situations on the site (near-accidents), contact the security organization via the radio's channel 1. They assess whether simple precautions are sufficient or whether the festival management should be involved.

In the event of an accident or injury, contact the first aid emergency department on site. These carry out processing and documentation and forward the documentation to the security organization which informs the festival management.

Both types of inquiries are made to the security organization on the radio's channel 1.
