Rules and terms for press accreditation at NorthSide 2024:

You must apply for press accreditation to NorthSide if you wish to cover the festival for a media outlet.

Accreditation grants journalists and photographers access to the festival and the enclosed press zone, where they can work.

All media outlets are welcome to apply, but we cannot guarantee accreditation for everyone.

There are several things you can do to improve your chances of being accredited. You can:

- Provide a serious description of why you want accreditation to NorthSide and what your editorial goals are with the accreditation: How do you plan to cover the festival? What audience are you catering to? What will be your focus area(s)? How many articles/reviews/photos/posts/videos/radio broadcasts, etc., do you expect to produce, and when do you plan to publish your material?
- Apply well in advance if you have plans for significant productions during the festival (e.g., if you plan to record video and/or audio).
- Adhere to the deadline. The deadline this year is April 22, 2024.

Rules and terms for press accreditation to NorthSide:

- Press accreditation is personal and cannot, under any circumstances, be transferred to others. If you are unable to attend after receiving press accreditation, please promptly inform presse@northside.dk.
- Show respect to other journalists and photographers in the press zone and to the festival's staff, volunteers, and, of course, guests.
- Ensure compliance with GDPR rules (e.g., regarding photography on the premises).
- Adhere to the general safety rules on the premises. Read more at northside.dk/faq.
- Failure to comply with these rules may result in the immediate cancellation of your accreditation.
